## Clue 01

Just before the Lady Beckett's Yard on the right hand side, there's a blue plaque at the entrance to Pizza Hut. The blue plaque is all about Joseph Rowntree giving you the surname of JOSEPH.

The image on the front cover is taken from the entrance to the Merchant Adventurers Hall and the words MERCHANTS HALL are written above the doorway. The answer is an anagram of these two words.

## Clue 03

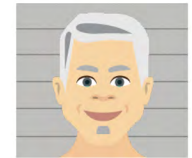

The code in the clue refers to the five words on the replica tablet and the letters in those words. The 4th letters in the last two words are R and T.

## Clue 08

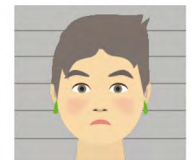
